- To increase quality of career guidance by improving the students' ability to judge their skills and find a suitable job.

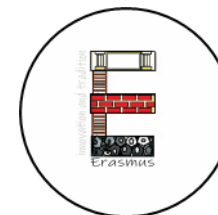
